As required by the Indiana Access to Public Records Act (APRA), this letter is the Wabash County Sheriff's Office's (WCSO) initial response to your written records request made by email dated August 11, 2026. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 5-14-3-3, WCSO will provide copies of or allow the inspection of the public records requested during regular business hours within a reasonable time after a request was received.

Indiana Code § 5-14-3-8.1 allows a public agency to prioritize responding to public records requests based on the residency of the requestor and the purpose of the request. Please complete the provided Records Request Information Sheet to assist in determining the correct response time required.

Under the APRA, certain documents, records, or other information may be treated as confidential or otherwise exempt from disclosure under Federal and State law. If any of the records requested are exempt from disclosure you will be notified. As well, if any requested documents, records, or other information does not exist or is not in the possession of WCSO, there is no obligation for WCSO to create or obtain such documents, records, or other information for disclosure. All public records requested that are not exempt from disclosure will be made available for inspection and copying.

Please be aware that if you desire physical copies of any public documents, the copying fee will be \$0.10 per page or the actual cost of copying any recording, which must be paid in advance in accordance with Indiana Code § 5-14-3-8 and Wabash County Ordinance 2012-85-16.
